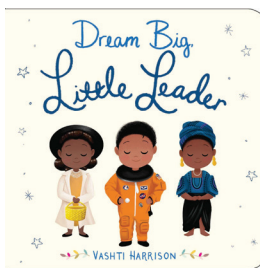




AYESHA CURRY'S MUST-READ BOOKS

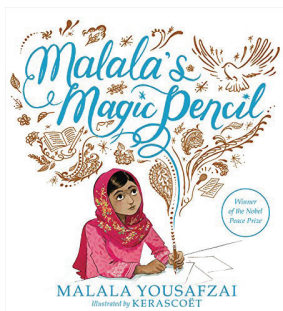
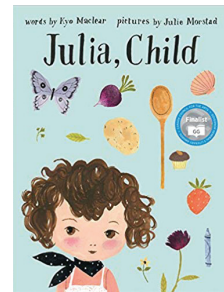
Ayesha Curry, a *New York Times* bestselling author, television host, and mother of three, is the spokesperson and chair for the 100th anniversary of Children's Book Week!
