Mouse stands on their back legs.

Word balloon: How does it work?

Young animal starts reading out loud – looking very happy

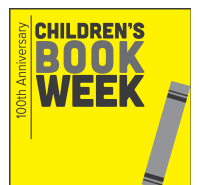
Word balloon: “It was a dark and stormy night...”

Panel eight and on

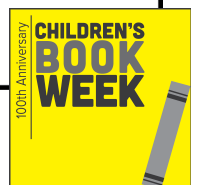
You create the story that the dog is reading to the mouse! Draw and write a comic that starts with the words right after: “It was a dark and stormy night...”
