We are asking young people across the country to tell us their superpowers and we want to know yours, too!

During Children's Book Week, May 3 - 9, tell the world one of your superpowers via your social media channels. You can share your superpower in a myriad of ways.

- A Quote: 1 2 sentences about your superpower
- A short video: filmed on your phone in vertical orientation, no more than 1 min talking about your superpower
  - A drawing: Draw yourself embodying your superpower
  - A poem
  - A photo: dress up and take a shot, we would need a short caption to explain your superpower
  - Any of the above for one of your characters
  - Anything else you can think of that is social media appropriate
