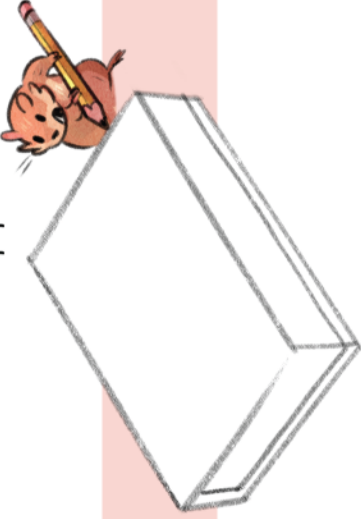
Also known as a book.



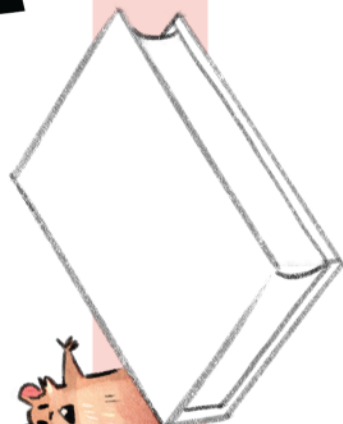
1: Draw a squished cube (the cube that makes many objects).



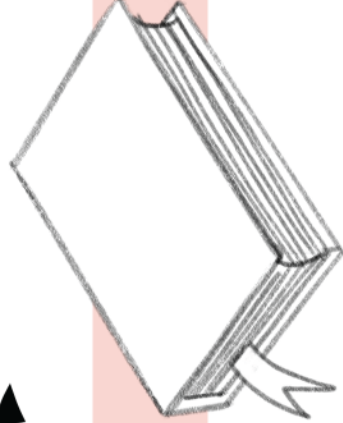
2: Add a few lines to show the paper.



3: Show the curve of the pages and erase the lines you don't want. It's now a book, but boring. Let's make it interesting!



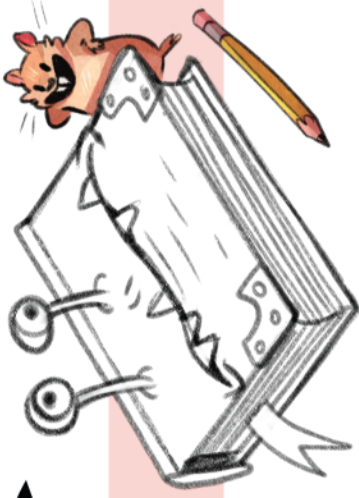
4: Draw the paper lines and add an old-timey book mark (because all books need old-timey book marks)



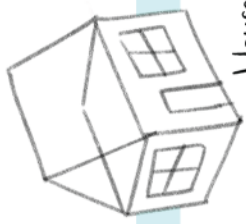
5: Add corner edges, nifty spine, and an truly awesome title.



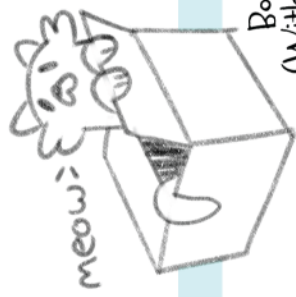
6: Add eyes, teeth, and a deep ravenous hunger because SOME books are actually monsters lying in wait to eat your hands.



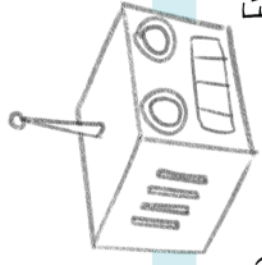
The humble cube (squished or otherwise) can be used to draw all kinds of neat stuff!



House!

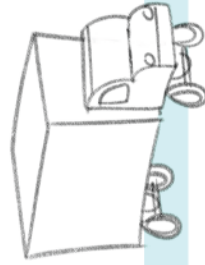


Box! (With cat).
